1. Call to Order

Jake Thompson, Radio Chair called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

2. Approval of Agenda

Victoria Vadnais moved to approve the agenda for September 21,2021 meeting. Susan Bowler seconded. Motion carried.

3. Approval of Minutes

Nick Schatz moved to approve the minutes from the July 28,2021 meeting. Susan Bowler seconded. Motion carried.

Action Items

A. COMU Recognitions/Renewals

i. Sara Boucher-Jackson COML/INTD renewal

ii. Curt Meyer COML renewal

Tracey Fredrick said both candidates met the minimum requirements for renewals.

Jeff Bjorklund moved to approve Boucher-Jackson and Curt Meyer COML certification renewals. Mark VandenBerghe seconded. Motion carried.

B. Isanti County Participation Plan Amendment

Chris Caulk said Isanti County is looking to amend their participation plan to include a patch for smartphones and other LTE devices.

Rod Olson asked Michael Kahl of Granite Electronics what was being interfaced; if it was just different cell phone types. Kahl said the donor radios are XTL and XTS portables and mobiles, interfacing into the RSP 2Z device, and once connected to the internet, the Sheriff has access to those channels.

Jake Thompson said it is similar to the WAVE product Anoka County has.

Motion made by Curt Meyer to approve the Isanti County Participation Plan Amendment to

approve the patch capability for LTE devices. Nate Timm seconded. Motion carried.

Caulk asked if the motion included the addition for six talkgroups.

Olson asked if these were statewide or local talkgroups. Caulk confirmed these are just local talkgroups.

Amended Motion made by Curt Meyer to approve the Isanti County Participation Plan Amendment to approve the patch and additional local talk groups. Nate Timm seconded. Motion carried.

C. Carver County CCGW Addition

Susan Bowler said Carver County is replacing its back-up consolettes. Carver County is asking to add an 8 port CCGW for five consolettes. At current time, Carver County will only be using five ports.

Motion made by Nick Schatz to approve the Carver County CCGW addition. Curt Meyer seconded Motion carried.

D. Standard 3.14.0 Update

Fredrick said this Standard was presented to the Radio TOC in July. It was kicked back to the work group. They did not have any further changes at this time.

Fredrick asked if there were any volunteers to replace Mike Mihelich on the LMR Committee. Curt Meyer volunteered.

i. Steering

Jill Rohret said she did not attend but the committee did meet in September. The SCIP plan was discussed.

ii. LMR

Nate Timm said at the September 14 meeting, there were revisions to standards. SCIP goals were discussed. MnDOT T1 to Ethernet transition plans were discussed. A couple of standards were approved at the August meeting. A couple of southern counties applied for interoperability.

iii. WBBA

Rod Olson said the Wireless Broadband and Applications Committee met yesterday. Dave Deal is stepping down from this committee because he is retiring from the Washington County Sheriff's Office. Brandon Larson is the Co-Chair and will assume the Chair position. Main topics discussed were SCIP updates, a gold metric for the cellular carrier representatives to meet with the WBBA three times or more per year. The work group met and had reports and highlights from the National APCO conference. The group will be working on common Q and A cellular carrier questions. FirstNet has reported Baudette and Peterson sites have been brought up. Four more sites are due to be brought up before the end of the year. Cook County reported some cell sites are being built. Stearns County said the FirstNet response team was deployed twice.

Jake Thompson said the Interoperability Committee met yesterday. SCIP goals were discussed. Standards IOP-1 and IOP-27 were reviewed. COML renewal approval for Tom Groninga.

Fredrick said there has just been one new request from Dilworth PD for one officer to use for METAC 1-10 for U of M events.

Nate Timm said he has not bothered with the process since officers working the U of M events are then metro officers. Fredrick asked if those officers are bringing their own radios or using radios that the U of M is providing; if they are using their own outstate radio, they should be getting permissions approved.

B. Motorola Customer Services Discussion

Jeff Lessard said the last couple orders placed with Motorola have experienced significant errors and delays. VandenBerghe said Eden Prairie has experienced the same.

Jeff Bjorklund said Sara Boucher-Jackson is the new PSAP Manager at the Airport and will be the alternate to the MAC.
