Kahl said the donor radios are XTL and XTS portables and mobiles, interfacing into the RSP 2Z device, and once connected to the internet, the Sheriff has access to those channels.

Jake Thompson said it is similar to the WAVE product Anoka County has.

Susan Bowler said Carver County is replacing its back-up consolettes. Carver County is asking to add an 8 port CCGW for five consolettes. At current time, Carver County will only be using five ports.

Fredrick said this Standard was presented to the Radio TOC in July. It was kicked back to the work group. They did not have any further changes at this time.

### **iii. WBBA**

Rod Olson said the Wireless Broadband and Applications Committee met yesterday. Dave Deal is stepping down from this committee because he is retiring from the Washington County Sheriff's Office. Brandon Larson is the Co-Chair and will assume the Chair position. Main topics discussed were SCIP updates, a gold metric for the cellular carrier representatives to meet with the WBBA three times or more per year. The work group met and had reports and highlights from the National APCO conference. The group will be working on common Q and A cellular carrier questions. FirstNet has reported Baudette and Peterson sites have been brought up. Four more sites are due to be brought up before the end of the year. Cook County reported some cell sites are being built. Stearns County said the FirstNet response team was deployed twice.

Nate Timm said he has not bothered with the process since officers working the U of M events are then metro officers. Fredrick asked if those officers are bringing their own radios or using radios that the U of M is providing; if they are using their own outstate radio, they should be getting permissions approved.

### **B. Motorola Customer Services Discussion**

Jeff Lessard said the last couple orders placed with Motorola have experienced significant errors and delays. VandenBerghe said Eden Prairie has experienced the same.

Jeff Bjorklund said Sara Boucher-Jackson is the new PSAP Manager at the Airport and will be the alternate to the MAC.


